Purpose of This Document

This document defines technical requirements for objects used within the UJINN Cake Ceremony.

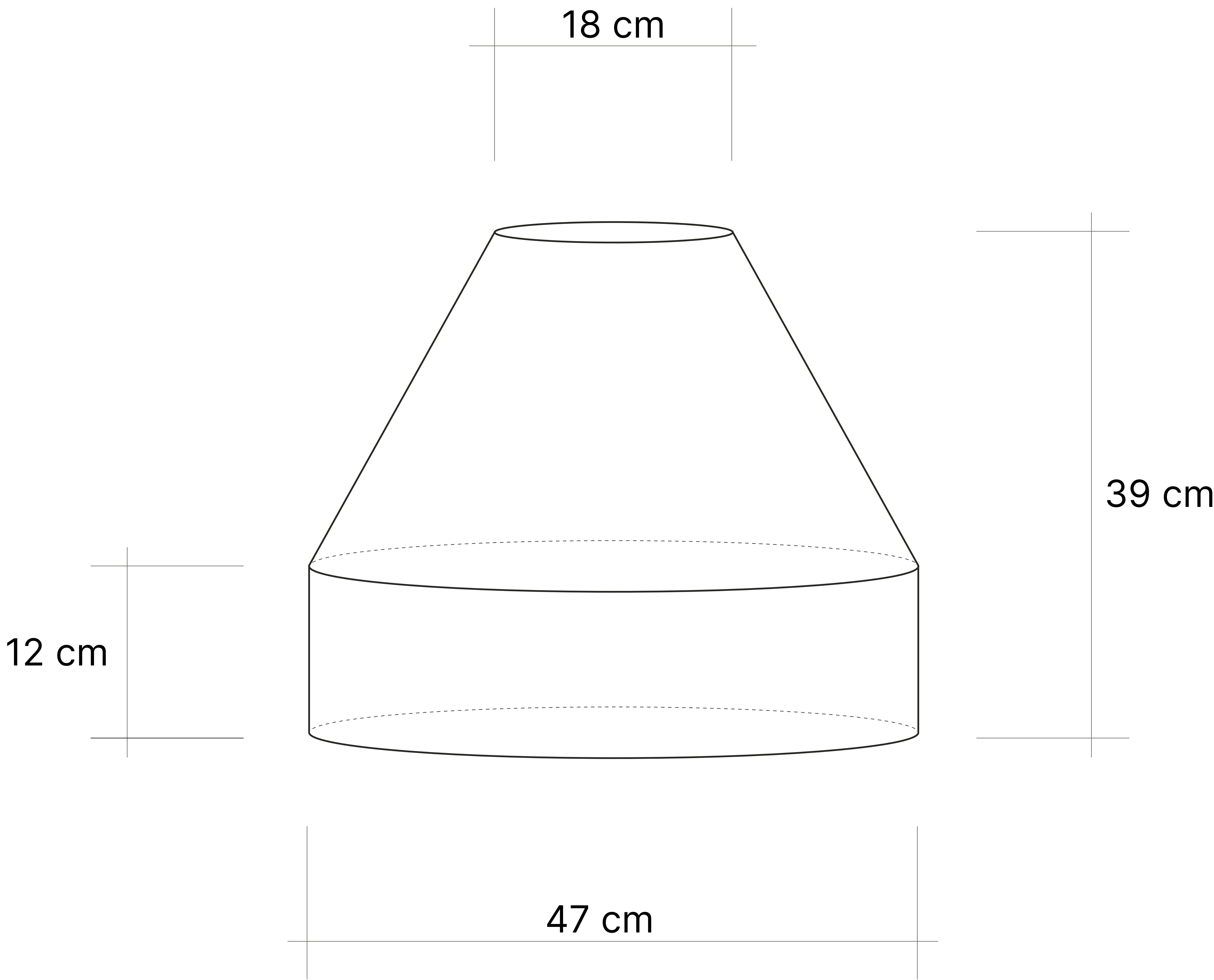
Its purpose is to ensure compatibility between the object, venue conditions and performance equipment.

The document does not limit the creative aspect of the project.

Shape, style, colour palette, number of tiers, decoration and contents remain at the discretion of the client and contractor.

Maximum Dimensions for Conical Objects



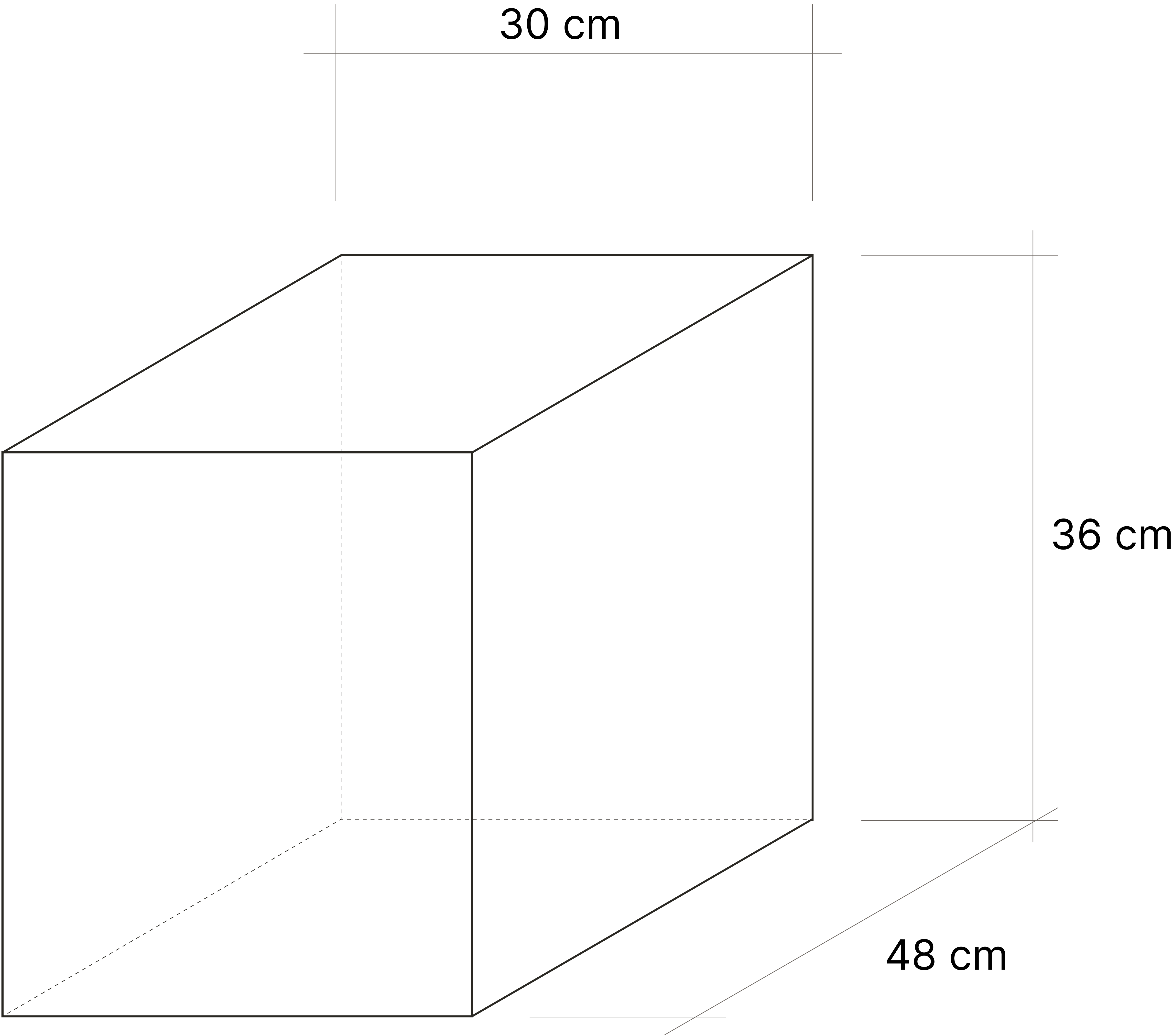
— NOTES

Object may include:

- cake;
- gift box;
- decorative composition;
- combined structure.

All decorative elements, figurines, flowers, candles and protruding parts of the structure must remain within the specified dimensions.

Maximum Dimensions for Cubic Objects



— NOTES

Object may include:

- cake;
- gift box;
- decorative composition;
- combined structure.

All decorative elements, figurines, flowers, candles and protruding parts of the structure must remain within the specified dimensions.

Before the Ceremony

The object must arrive no later than one hour before the ceremony begins.

This time is required for equipment setup, compatibility checks and preparation for stage presentation.

— OBJECT SPECIFICS

If the object has any storage limitations, temperature requirements or restrictions regarding room-temperature exposure, these must be communicated in advance.

Any structural characteristics affecting transportation, assembly or stability must also be disclosed prior to the event.

— FOR CEREMONY PREPARATION

Please provide in advance:

- visual references or renderings of the object;
- overall dimensions;
- contractor contact information.
